Mayor Jeter read Ordinance 2025-03 Amend 2024-2025 budget; Ordinance 2025-04 Approve 2025-2026 budget; Ordinance 2025-05 Amend garbage rates; no public comments or questions.

Approval to adopt financial statements as presented made by Spiller, 2nd by Perkins, motion unanimously carried.

Unfinished Business: 1) Motion to adopt the Ordinance approving 2024-2025 amended budget made by Carroll 2nd by Perkins, motion carried; Ordinance approving 2025-2026 budget made by Perkins, 2nd by Spiller, motion carried; Ordinance amend garbage rates made by Carroll, 2nd by Spiller, motion carried.

New Business: 1) Resolution 2025-07 to Adopt 2025 Millage Rate at 4.81 mills motion made by Carroll, 2nd by Perkins, motion carried.

Police Chief Dixon presented police report. Jason Murphy presented engineer report; Greg Jones had nothing to report. Mayor Jeter called for public comments/concerns, there were none. With no further business, motion to adjourn was made by Spiller, second by Carroll, motion unanimously carried.
