**PUBLIC MEETING MINUTES**

On Nov 14,2023 at 6:00pm Mayor Elizabeth Jeter and the Board of Alderman of the Village of Forest Hill conducted a public meeting at Forest Hill Municipal Complex, Room 2, 138 Blue Lake Rd, Forest Hill, LA 71430.

Mayor Jeter called the meeting to order@ 6:00pm. Roll call: Present Mayor Jeter, Council members Belinda Spiller, Garland Carroll and Danny Perkins present, quorum met. Also present were attorney Greg Jones and Police Chief Dixon. Invocation led by Greg Jones. Pledge led by HH Spiller. Mayor Jeter welcomed everyone. Public comments on agenda items: None. Approval to adopt 10/10/23 minutes as published made by Alderperson Spiller; second by Alderperson Carroll, motion unanimously carried. Approval to adopt financial statements as presented made by Spiller, second by Perkins, motion unanimously carried.

Old Business: None.

New Business: 1) Fiscal year 2022-2023 financial audit report present by Nicholas Fowlkes with Kolder, Slaven & Co, LLC. There were no findings, clean results materially correct. 2) Resolution 2023-07 to surplus and sell 2017 Ford Police vehicle. Approval was made by Carroll; second by Spiller, motion unanimously carried. 3) Approval to hire Randle Raymond as a part time police officer on a 90- day probation period was made by Carroll, second by Spiller, motion unanimously carried. 4) Canopy at Town Hall approval made by Carroll, second by Spiller, motion unanimously carried.

Chief Glynn Dixon presented police report. He also advised he would like to extend the probation period of A. Washington, approved by Carroll, second by Spiller, motion carried. No engineer or utility report. Greg Jones presented attorney report. Motion to enter executive session made by Carroll; second by Spiller, motion unanimously carried. Executive Session closed.
